On Sunday mornings in person, we are serving 3-5 year olds & K-3<sup>rd</sup> graders on a small scale. Virtually & in other creative ways, we come alongside families as they grow spiritually. ## Transformation Team

These teams transform the McDaniel Field into a place of worship, and then back into an empty field again, every Sunday. It's not rocket science, it's more important than that. ## Worship Arts

## Intercessor

This is us recognizing first and foremost that our efforts are nothing without the redeeming power of our Lord, and He has made it quite clear that 'asking' of Him is a good thing! These inconspicuous volunteers pray through our corporate worship times on Sunday mornings and intercede for our people during the week.

## Audio/Video Tech

The a/v tech team creatively uses all marvels of technology to assure our worship spaces are fully seen, heard, and experienced by all who would come...both in person and remotely. There are a variety of positions available here, including (but not limited to) audio mixing, computer media, general setup, and online streaming.

## Musician

The musicians use their instruments and voices to lead our congregation in experiencing, responding to, and delighting in the greatness of God through music. Pretty simple. If you play an instrument, you should really reach out...you might be surprised what we say yes to!

## Building, Aesthetics & Visual Art

This group isn't necessarily active every week, but remains at the ready for special projects, worship elements, and general design needs.
